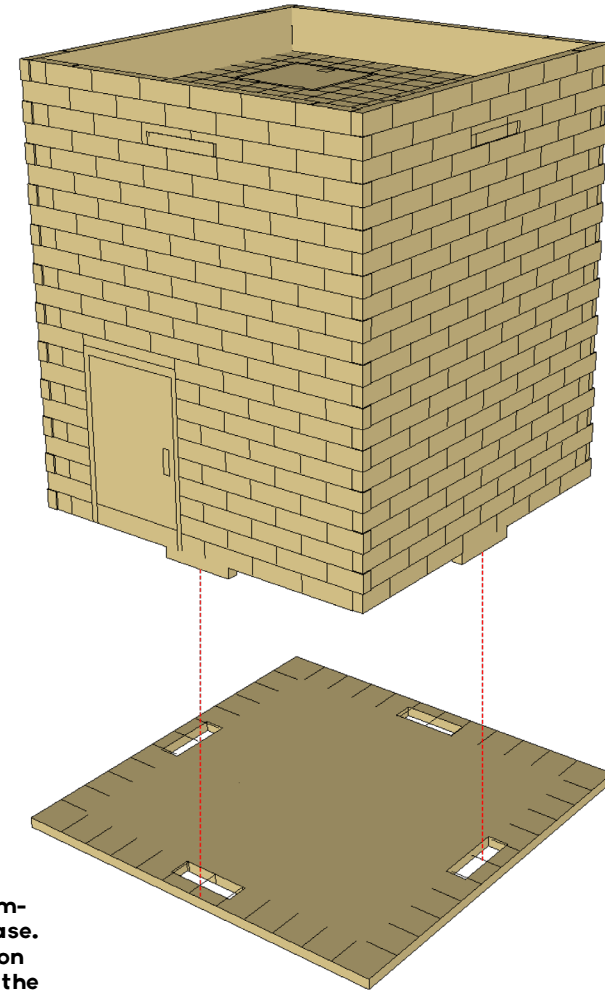
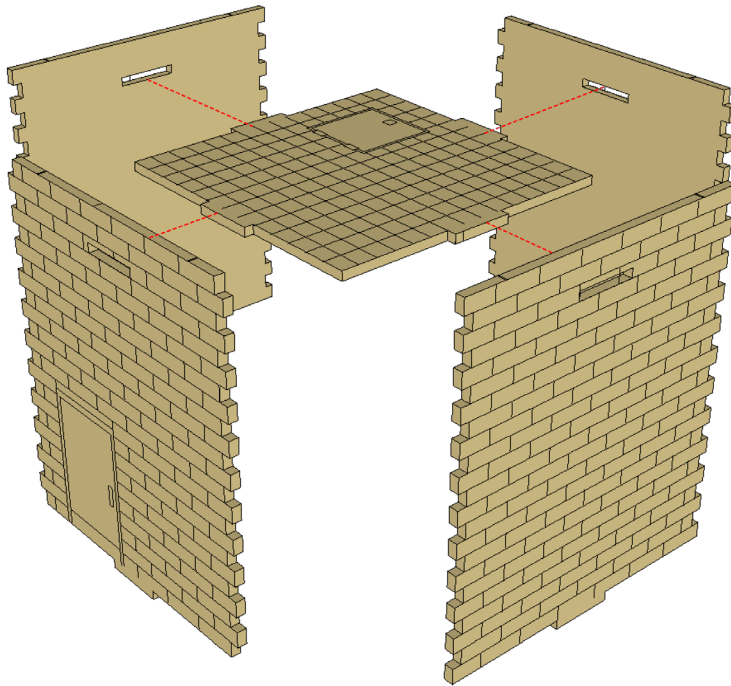


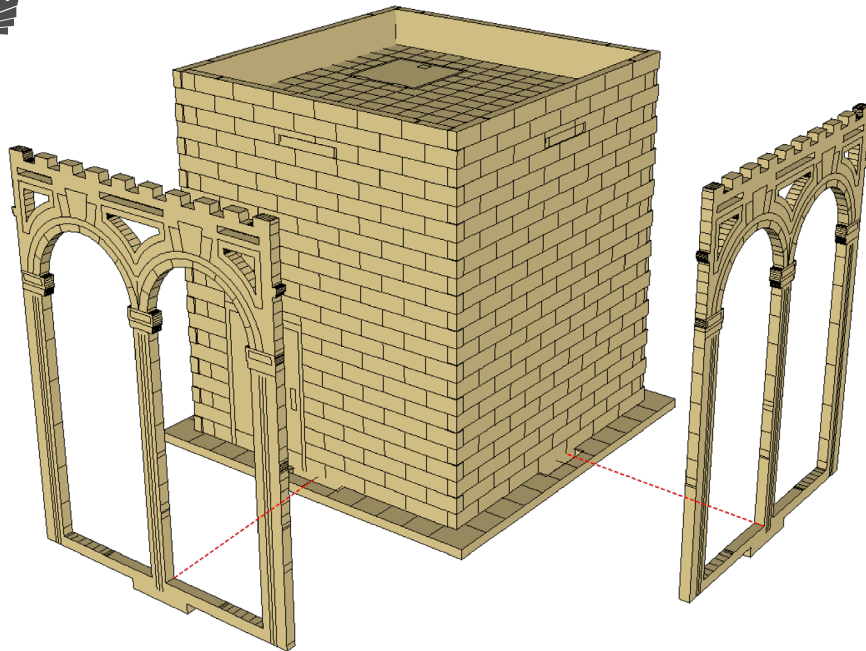
ELEVATOR SHAFT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

We've found it easier to first glue one wall onto the roof, then work around the model applying glue to the new piece before popping into place. Work your way around until all 4 walls are in place

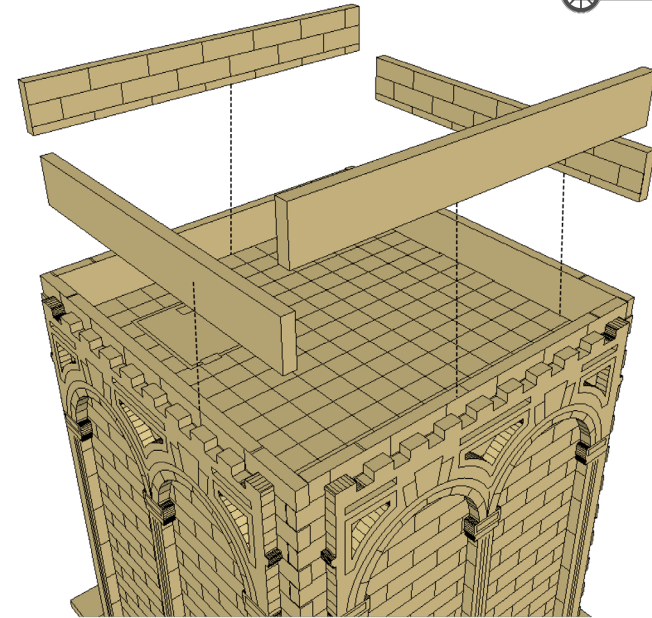


Once all 4 walls and the roof are assembled you can slot them down on the base. You will notice extra room in the slots on the base, these are for the facades in the following steps

All the facades are the same on this kit. We find it useful to first apply glue to the back of the facade and then from an angle insert it into the slot on the base and press it up against the wall



It is always a good idea to dry fit the roof linings as usually there are 2 long pieces and 2 short pieces. Glue the long pieces in first opposite each other, then glue in place the 2 remaining pieces
