




This is a kit that will be difficult to paint once assembled, and therefore would benefit from some painting of parts or sub-asemblies before construction. Take some time to review these instructions carefully and figure out the best way to go about this that works for you. Pre-painting of parts can make some of the tollerances of tabs and slots a little tight, so we reccomend lightly sanding back the paint on tabs using fine grit sandpaper or small files to remedy this problem. One important note is that we reccomend not painting the outsides of the outter walls as this might interfere with the tollerance when slipping the interior kit into your exisiting theatre model.
