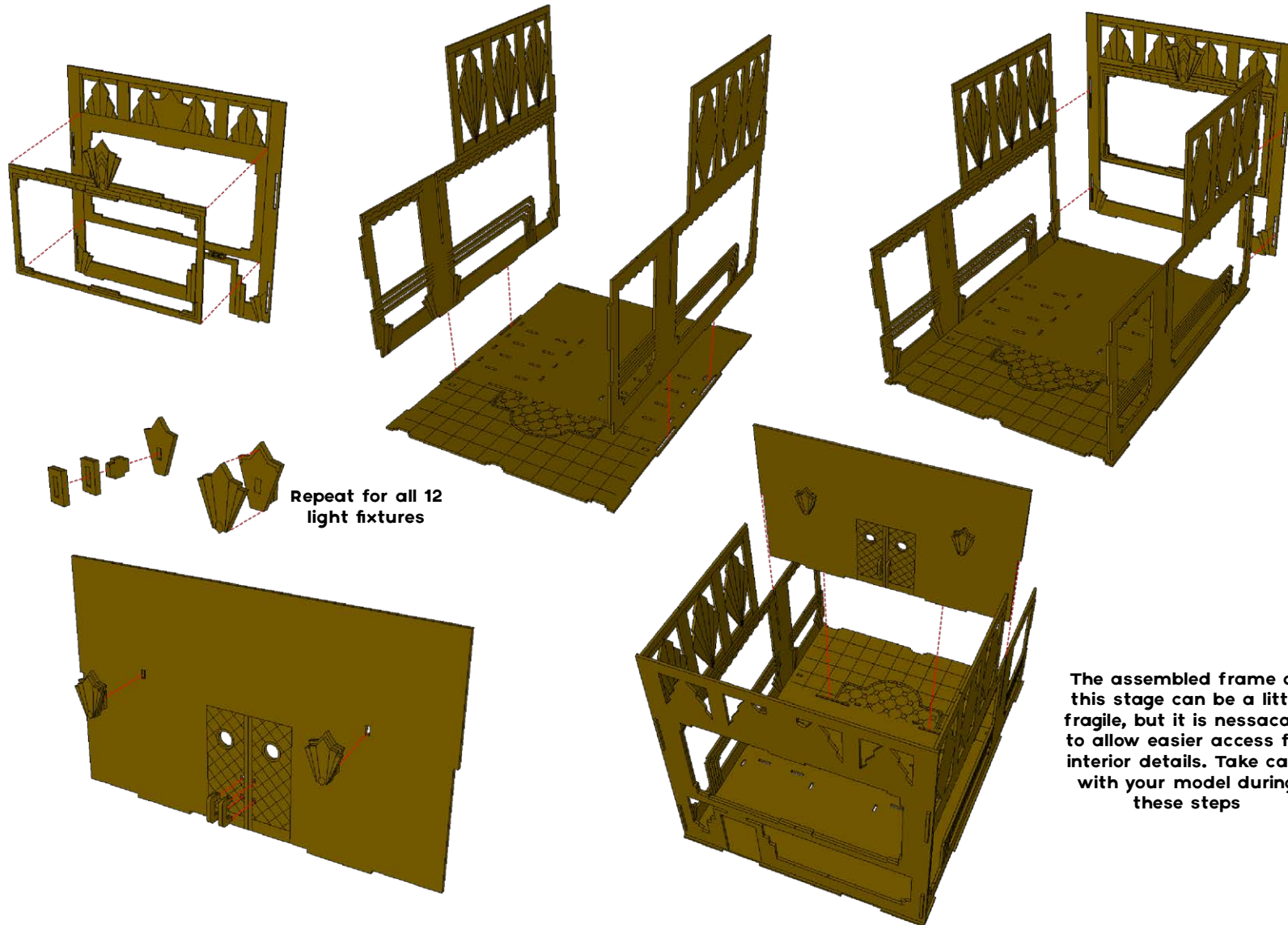




HARMONIC THEATRE INTERIOR KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



This is a kit that will be difficult to paint once assembled, and therefore would benefit from some painting of parts or sub-assemblies before construction. Take some time to review these instructions carefully and figure out the best way to go about this that works for you. Pre-painting of parts can make some of the tolerances of tabs and slots a little tight, so we recommend lightly sanding back the paint on tabs using fine grit sandpaper or small files to remedy this problem. One important note is that we recommend not painting the outsides of the outer walls as this might interfere with the tolerance when slipping the interior kit into your existing theatre model.



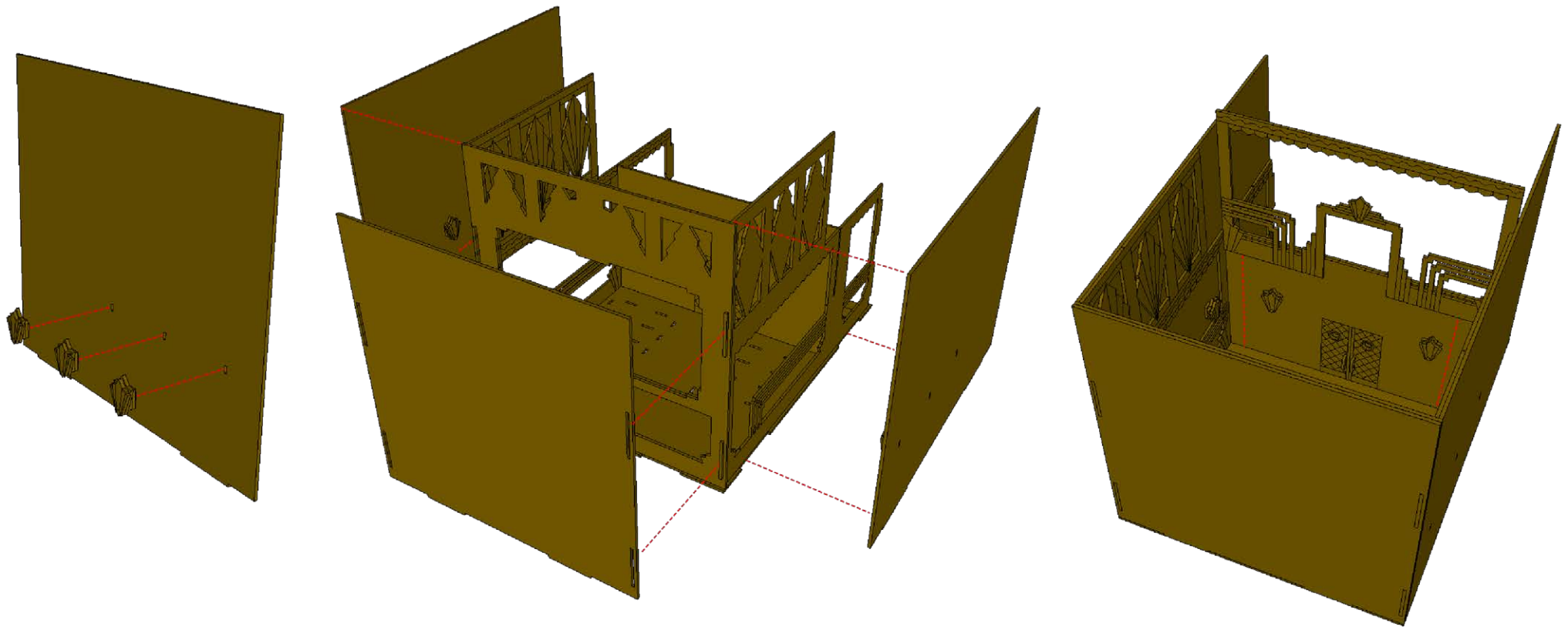
Following this step, allow plenty of time for the glue to dry before moving on to the next steps. If you want something to do while you wait, try assembling some of the standalone or drop in components

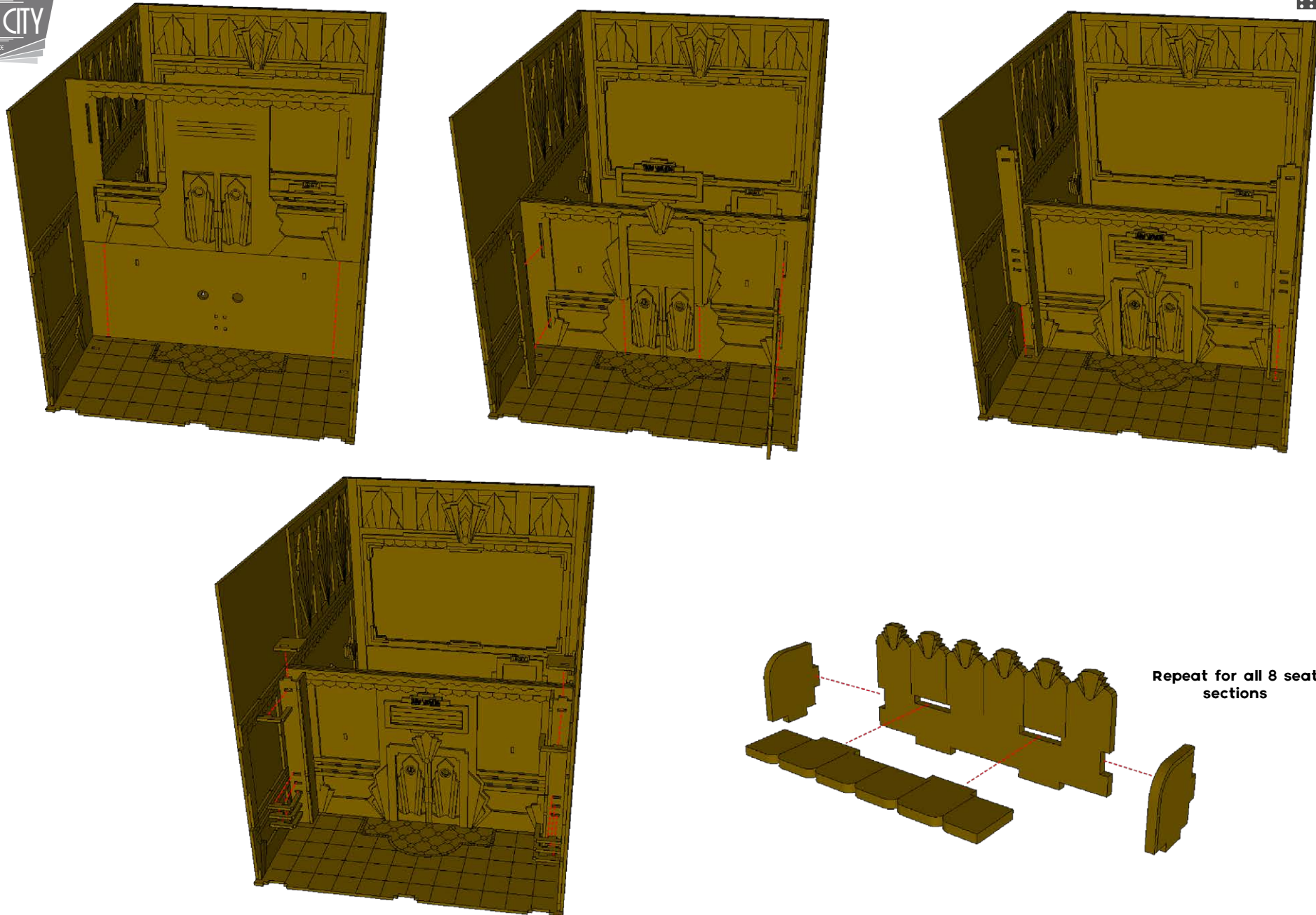
Repeat for all 12 light fixtures

The assembled frame at this stage can be a little fragile, but it is necessary to allow easier access for interior details. Take care with your model during these steps



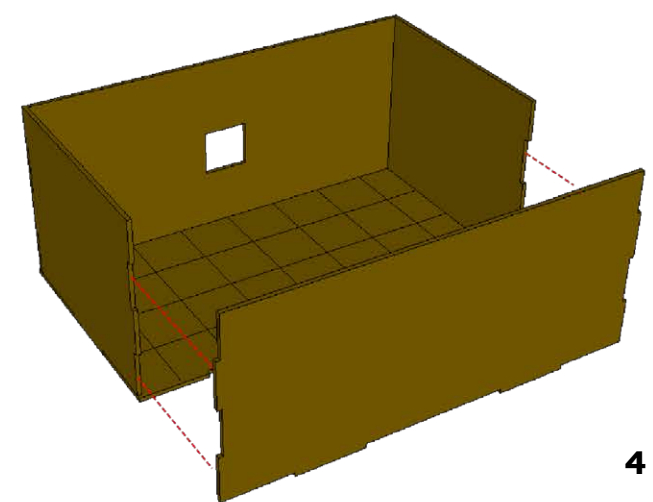
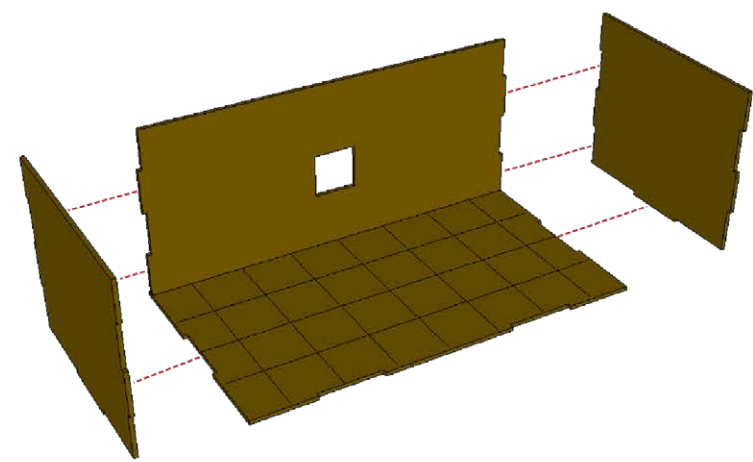
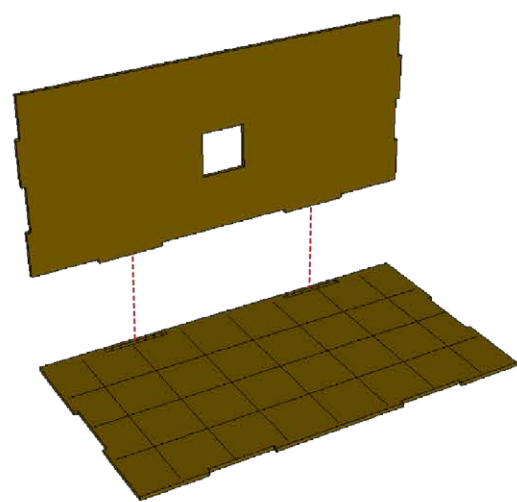
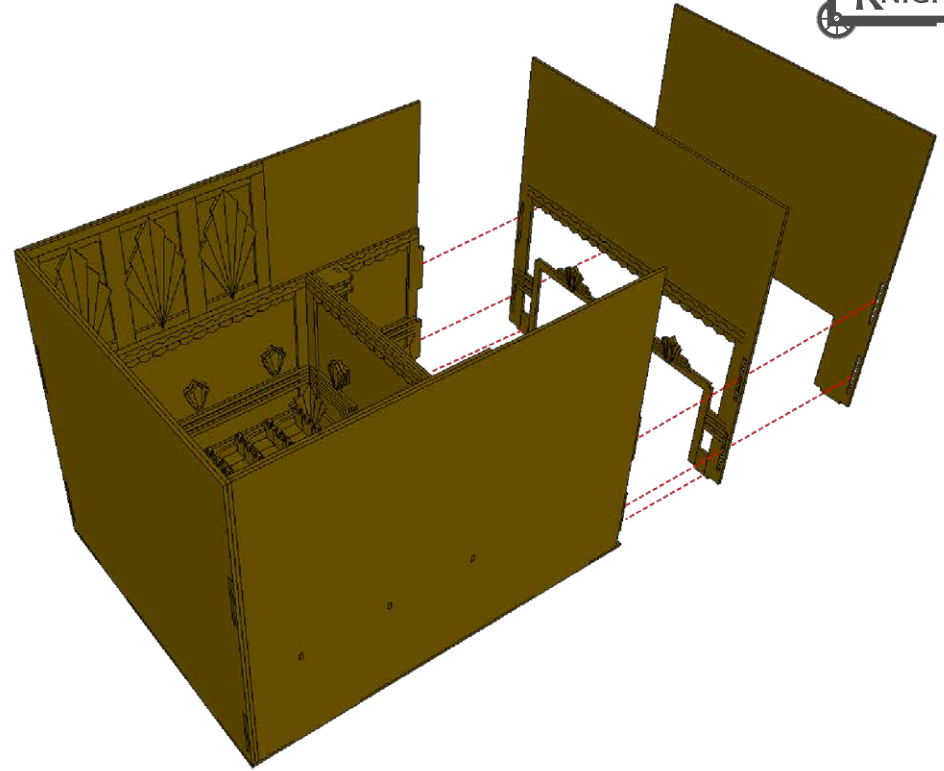
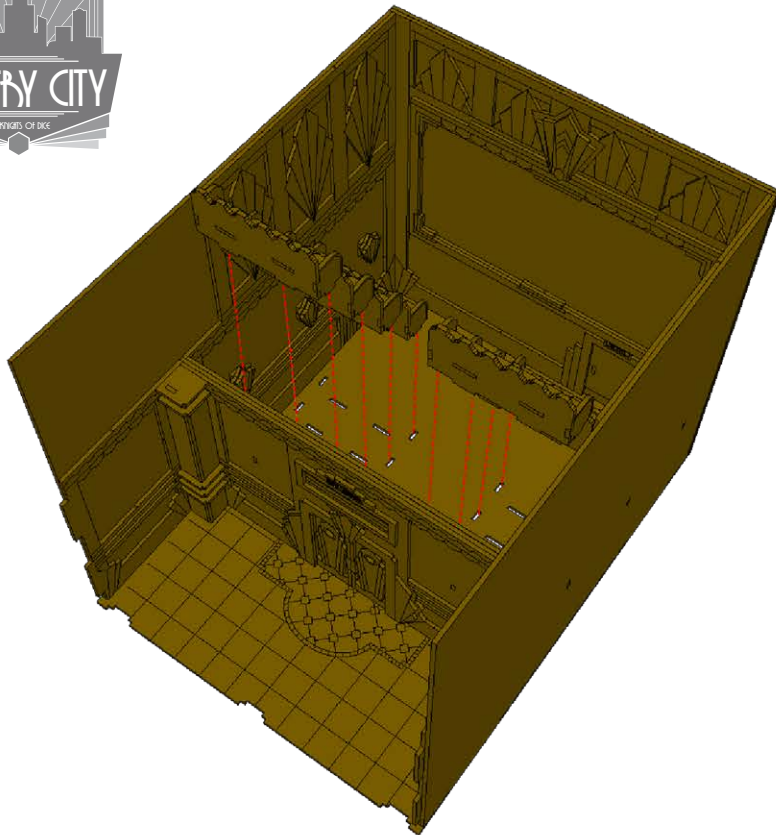

The projector has many small parts and can be a tad fiddly to assemble. Review these instructions carefully and take your time



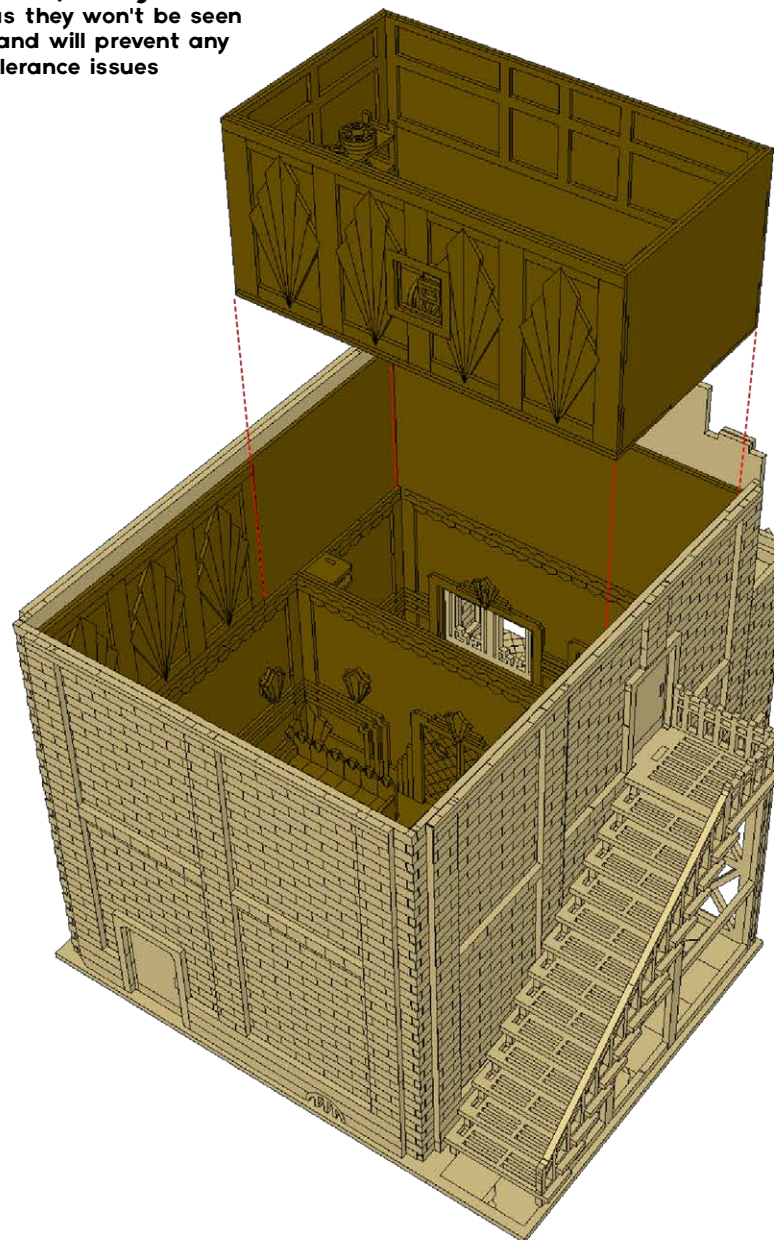
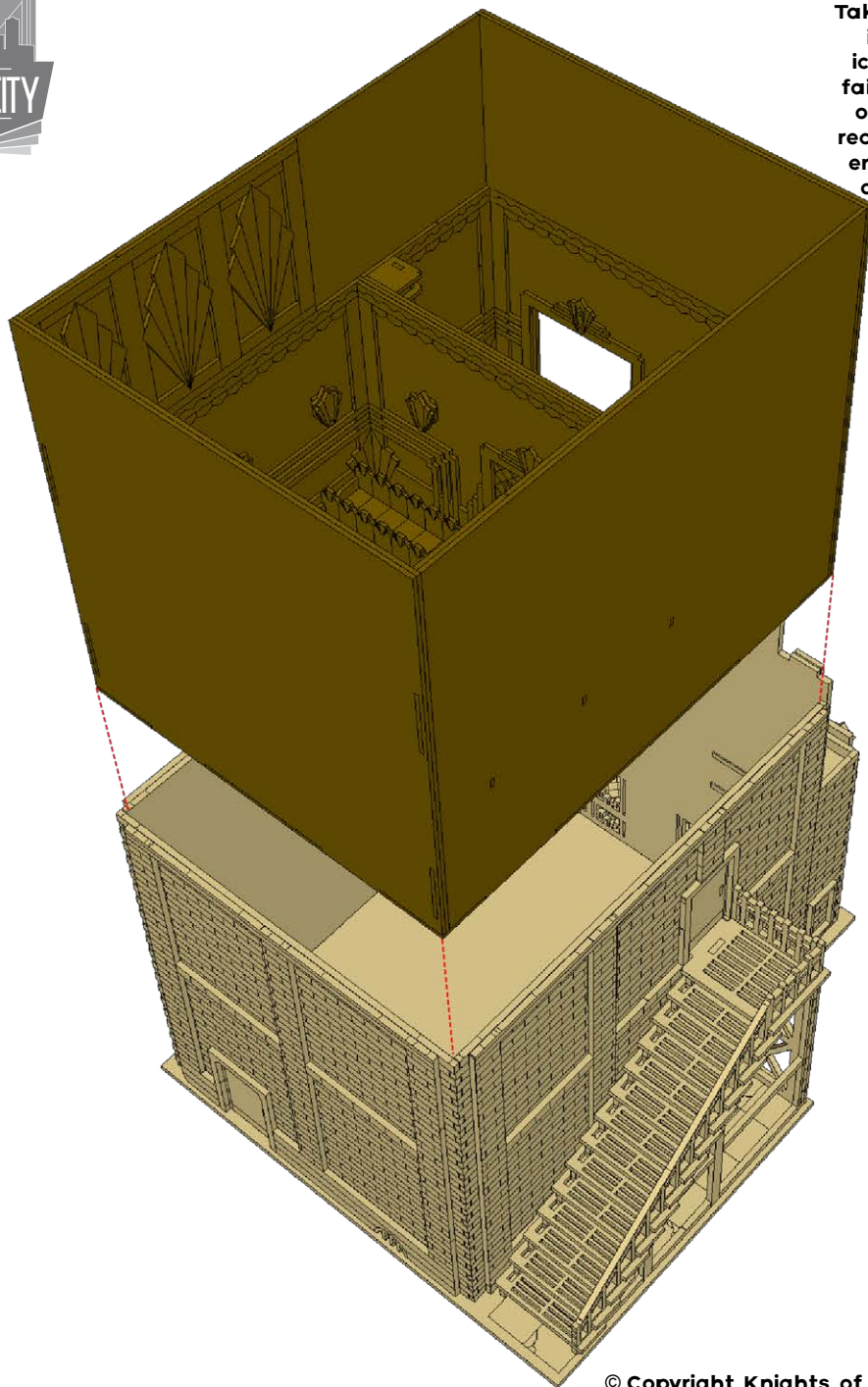

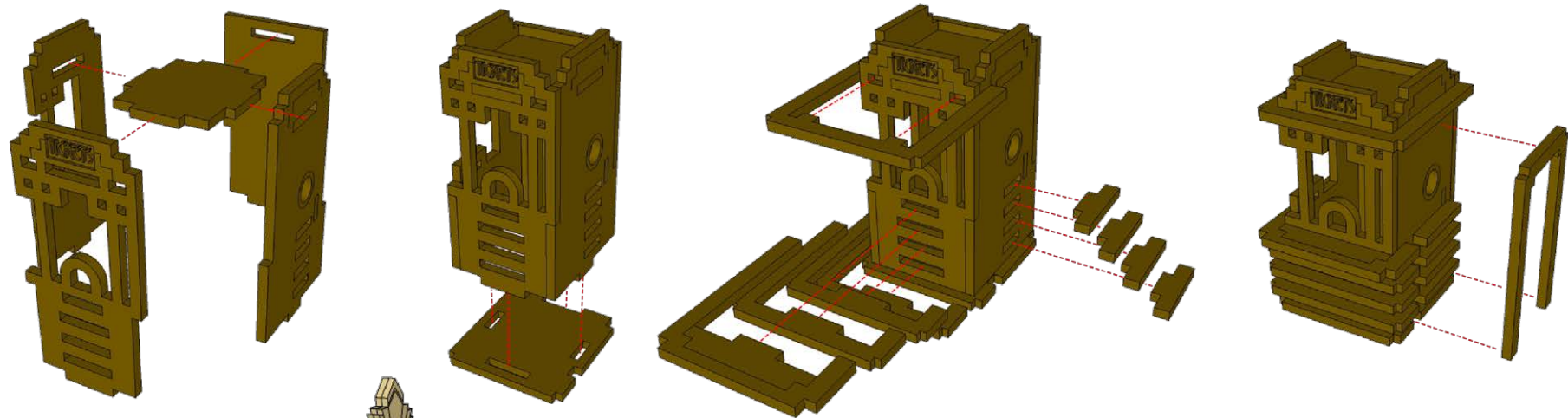
Place your projector room furniture anywhere you'd like. It might make sense to place the projector directly in from of the projection window though :)

Take your time inserting the room into your existing harmonic theatre kit. It should slip in fairly easily, depending on how you have painted it. We would recommend not painting the outer walls as they won't be seen anyway and will prevent any tolerance issues.



The projector room is designed to slip in and out of the building to allow access to the lobby and cinema, so resist the urge to glue it in place!



The kit includes a ticket booth as an additional piece of detail you can add to the outside of your harmonic theatre kit. Of course this can be placed in the lobby if you prefer, though space is pretty cramped in there already :)
