
We've found it useful to  
Apply glue to the facade pieces, then slot  
them into the holes on the base piece.  
Make sure you have the correct facade  
piece for the correct side (as some side  
have doors and corresponding facades).  
Small clamps or large elastic bands also  
help with securing the facade pieces  
while they dry







The construction of the rangehood can be a little bit fiddly. Take your time and be patient :)




