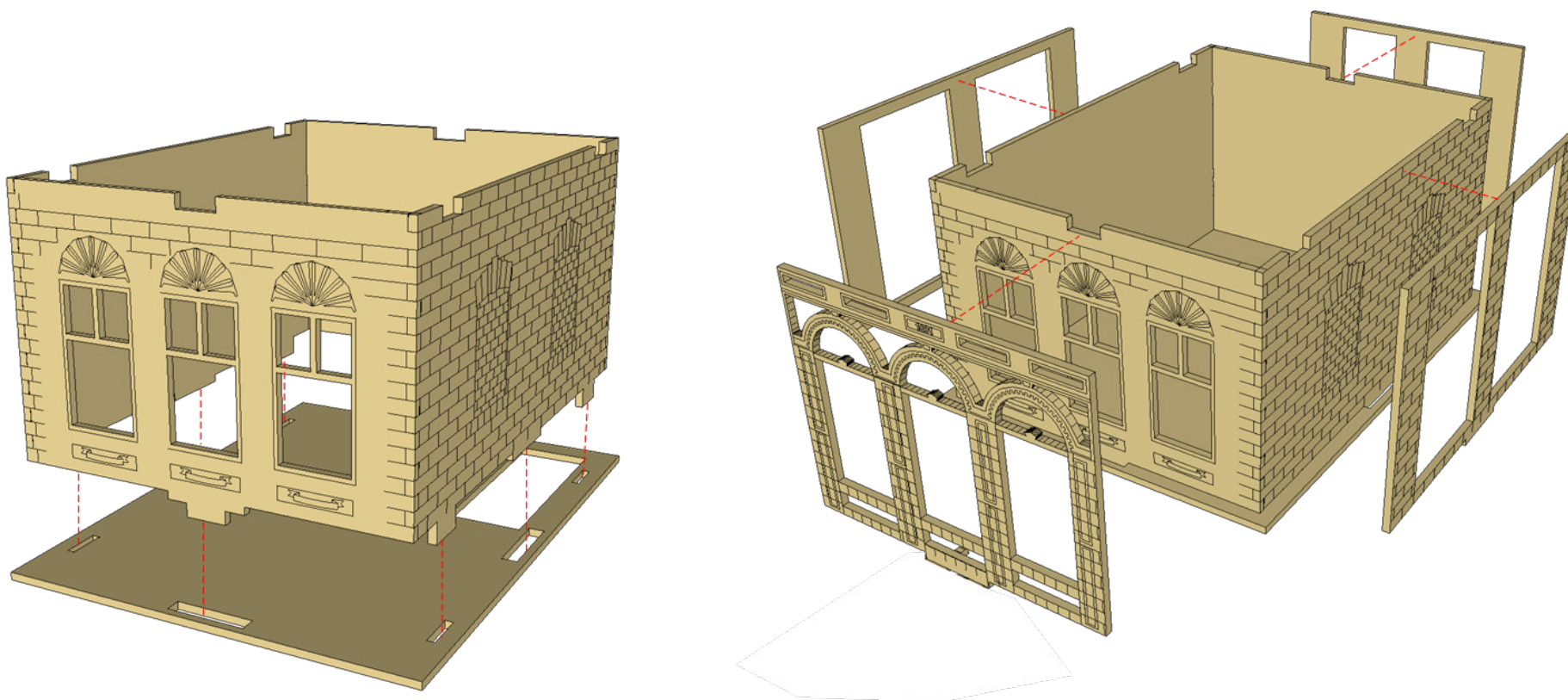


We've found it useful to

while they dry

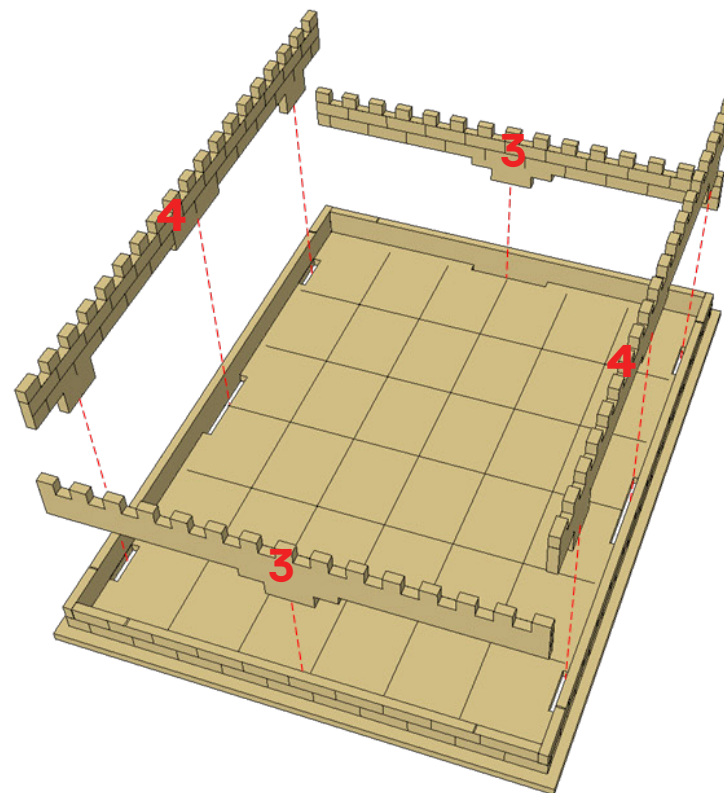
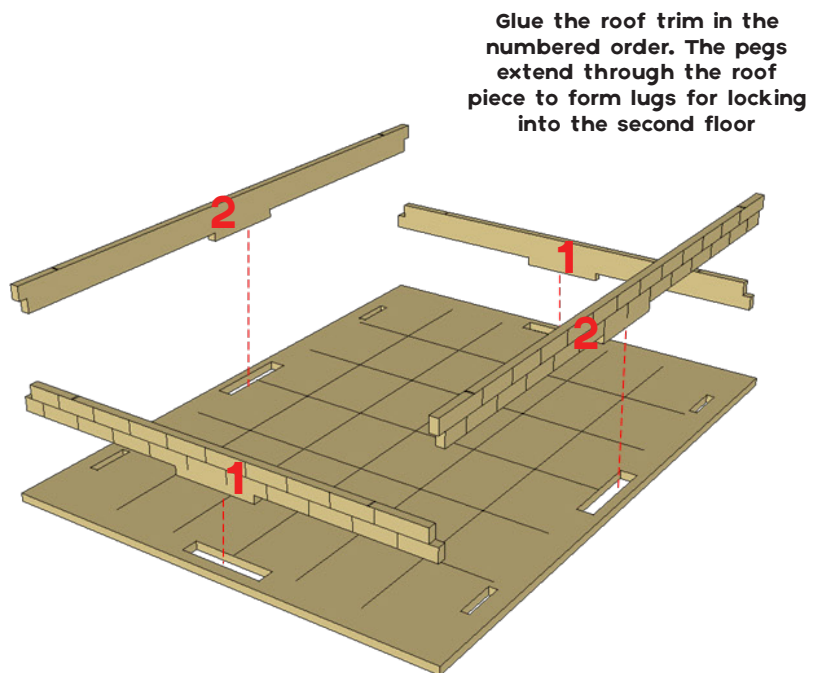
